New Members must be eligible to join and must complete and sign the form below.

American Legion Eligibility

□ Any person (Male or Female) who served at least <u>one day</u> of active duty in the military during any date after Dec 7, 1941 and who is either still serving honorably or has been honorably discharged, is eligible.

Family Membership Option: Post 435 Gun Club Memberships are *Family Memberships*. If your Spouse, regardless of his or her gender, is eligible for ANY American Legion organization, then you can become a Family Member of the Post 435 Gun Club once your Spouse has enrolled in a Legion Organization and the Post 435 Gun Club.

Need or Want to Prove Your Eligibility? To obtain Military Records on Department of Defense form DD-214, you need to submit a form SF-180 to the appropriate military service office.
